On behalf of Mountain Valley Pipeline, LLC (MVP), a joint venture between affiliates of EQT Midstream Partners, LP, NextEra Energy, Inc., Con Edison Gas Midstream, LLC, WGL Holdings, Inc., and RGC Midstream, LLC, you will find enclosed one (1) flash drive which contains a copy of the subject letter report. This letter report presents an assessment of one proposed variance, a temporary workspace MVP-ATWS-1627. This variance is located outside the boundary of previously recorded National Register of Historic Places (NRHP)-eligible Coles-Terry Rural Historic District (RHD) (080-5689) and within 500 meters (1,640 feet) of previously recorded potentially NRHP-eligible resource WDBJ Television/WSLQ-FM Radio Transmitting Facility (080-5675). No further cultural resources work is recommended for this variance.


