On behalf of Mountain Valley Pipeline, LLC (Mountain Valley), a joint venture between affiliates of EQT Midstream Partners, LP and NextEra Energy, Inc., Con Edison Midstream Gas, LLC, WGL Holdings, Inc., and RGC Midstream LLC, Tetra Tech is enclosing, in accordance with the approved *Mountain Valley Pipeline Project, Historic Property Treatment Plan Implementation: Management Summary, Work Plan, and Schedule, Underwood Farmstead (LE-0150)* (June 2018) (Management Summary), a draft West Virginia Development Grant Application (Application) for the property referenced above.

As detailed in the approved Management Summary, Tetra Tech has prepared the draft Application on behalf of the property owners with the assumption that the property is National Register of Historic Places-listed in the future and, as a result, becomes eligible for the grant program. According to the Management Summary, the Application will be submitted to WVDCH by the property owner following the property's receipt of the NRHP designation, if applicable. Editable and hard copies of the Application have been provided to the property owners and a copy of that transmittal is enclosed.

It should be noted that the grant application form requires a bid estimate from a contractor dated within two months of submittal of the final Application to WVDCH. For this reason, this portion of the Application remains incomplete at this time. Also, the enclosed Application is not being submitted to your office for review at this time; this submittal serves only as documentation to fulfill Section 106 responsibilities under the Programmatic Agreement and the approved Treatment Plan.
