The Department of Historic Resources (DHR) has received for review the report referenced above prepared by Tetra Tech for Mountain Valley Pipeline, LLC (MVP). It is our opinion that this report meets DHR's *Survey Guidelines* and other applicable standards. We provide the following comments as assistance to MVP and the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission in meeting their collective responsibilities under Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act.

This archaeological survey of 19.68 acres identified three (3) sites within the study area. The consultant recommends and DHR concurs that sites **44RN0400** and **44RN0401** are <u>potentially eligible</u> for listing in the National Register of Historic Places (NRHP) and that site **44RN0399** is <u>not eligible</u> for NRHP listing. Avoidance or Phase II evaluation is warranted for the two (2) potentially eligible sites.
