Mountain Valley Pipeline Project, Revised Historic Property Treatment Plan for the Bent Mountain Rural Historic District (080-0322), Bent Mountain Apple Orchard Rural Historic District (080-5731) and Coles Terry Rural Historic District (080-5689) (December 2017).

The Virginia Department of Historic Resources (VADHR) provided its comments on the draft Treatment Plan in a letter dated November 8, 2017. In that letter, VADHR supported the preparation of nominations to the National Register of Historic Places (NRHP) for the Bent Mountain Apple Orchard and Coles-Terry Rural Historic Districts and the preparation of a Property Inventory Form (PIF), which is a precursor to a NRHP nomination in Virginia, for the Bent Mountain Rural Historic District. The revised Treatment Plan includes consideration of these comments.

The Committee for Appalachian and Piedmont Preservation (Committee) and Mountain Valley Pipeline, LLC (Mountain Valley) entered into a Confidentiality and Protective Agreement dated July 15, 2015 (Confidentiality Agreement) with respect to privileged cultural information. You executed a non-disclosure certificate dated August 26, 2015 with respect to the Committee's Confidentiality Agreement, which made you a Reviewing Representative for the Committee. Mountain Valley has previously provided all applicable privileged cultural materials directly to Ann Rogers (Section 106 Coordinator for the Committee) pursuant to the Committee's Confidentiality Agreement. As a Reviewing Representative for the Committee, you were permitted to review the privileged information provided to Ms. Rogers.
