On October 23, 2015, Mountain Valley Pipeline, LLC (“Mountain Valley”) filed a certificate application with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (“Commission”) for the Mountain Valley Pipeline Project (“Project”) in the above-identified docket. On October 13, 2016 Mountain Valley filed materials related to its October 2016 Proposed Route. In this filing, Mountain Valley submits additional materials related to its October 2016 Proposed Route.

As stated in the transmittal letter accompanying its October 13, 2016 filing, Mountain Valley has taken steps to assist stakeholders and the Commission in evaluating the October 2016 Proposed Route.
