I fully agree that “A good faith Effort” has been made to have tribal monitors participate and they have backed out. ***MVP has met the terms of the permit in this respect.*** There are a ton of emails back and forth involving communications with the tribes and their statements that they would not have monitors on the ground but would like to have tribal archaeologists come out and visit the site when SEARCH is working on it. I believe those emails (copied into Galileo) substantiate my statement above and are all the proof needed for the proponent to move forward with the operation.
