Dear Ms. Pierce:

On behalf of Mountain Valley Pipeline, LLC, a joint venture between affiliates of EQT Corporation, NextEra Energy, Inc., Con Edison Gas Midstream, LLC, WGL Holdings, Inc., and RGC Midstream LLC, you will find enclosed two copies of the subject report.

The enclosed document is a revision of the January 2018 version of this report that has already been reviewed by West Virginia Division of Cultural and History (WVDCH). In a letter to the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) dated February 12, 2018, WVDCH indicated that it concurred with the archaeological Phase I survey recommendations and no further archaeological work is necessary. However, regarding architectural resources, WVDCH requested additional information (a revised report and HPI form) for the Huffman Farmstead (ME-0389) that comprises the circa-1900 barn reported on in the January 2018 version of this report.

Per WVDCH's request, this report has been revised accordingly and includes an HPI Form for the Huffman Farmstead (Appendix C). The barn is recommended as a contributing element to the Huffman Farmstead which is recommended eligible for listing in the National Register of Historic Places (NRHP) under Criteria A and C. Construction-related impacts on the barn will be avoided by a combination of avoidance, management, and minimization measures (detailed in Section 3.1 of the report) to ensure that the barn is not affected by use of the road during construction. These measures include those discussed in a telephone conversation between Tetra Tech architectural historian Hannah Dye and Mitchell Schaefer of WVDCH on March 13, 2018, and documented in an email from Mr. Schaefer dated March 13, 2018 (Appendix D).

No changes have been made to the archaeology sections of this report that already received WVDCH concurrence on February 12, 2018.

Please review this report under Stipulation IV.A. in the executed Programmatic Agreement for the project. This report will also be filed with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission, lead federal agency for the project. Per Stipulation IV.E., comments should be submitted to Paul Friedman at the FERC.
