Dear Mr. Friedman:

We have reviewed a letter of April 12, 2018 from Mountain Valley detailing a proposed temporary workspace within the historic property boundaries of the Cunningham Farmstead. As required by Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966, as amended, and its implementing regulations, U.S. 36 CFR § 800: "Protection of Historic Properties," we submit our comments.

Correspondence indicated a separate logging operation, of which our office was made aware in August 2017, is utilizing land surrounding the Cunningham Farmstead, which was considered eligible for inclusion in the National Register of Historic Places. Mountain Valley proposes to modify project plans to make use of some of that land as a temporary workspace (MVP-ATWS-1553). We concur the proposed project alteration will impose no additional adverse effects that warrant further consultation beyond what was delineated in the project Programmatic Agreement. We ask that you contact our office if that project component should change.
