Good afternoon Kim –

Thank you for your email this morning. I think the letter we provided to you recently confused you – I apologize for that. This project is one that has been going on for quite a while and most of your past contacts have come through Agnes Ramsey at NextEra (NextEra is a partner in this project while I am a consultant just assisting with the cultural resources side of things). This recent letter provides my contact information because we are actually implementing the Plan for Unanticipated Historic Properties and Human Remains – and that plan has me as the primary contact for cultural resources issues once we are into construction. Your tribe has been working with us for a number of years now and the Delaware Nation was identified in the plan as one of the interested tribes we should provide information to during construction if we found archaeological sites.

So bottom line, we reached out to you because you are a consulting party on this project and we had an unanticipated discovery we needed to report to you. I appreciate that you concur with our plan for this particular site. I'm hoping that we don't have many (or any) additional unanticipated discoveries – but if we do, we will certainly be reaching out to you and others per our plan. So that you don't have to go looking through files and such to find the plan, I've attached it to this email for your reference.

Please don't hesitate to call or email with other questions or concerns and we'll get you additional information as needed. Also, please feel free to contact Agnes directly. We work closely together on this aspect of the project so either one of us will do all we can to address your questions.

Evelyn,  
The protection of our tribal cultural resources and tribal trust resources will take all of us working together. We look forward to working with you and your agency.

With the information you have submitted we can concur at present with this proposed plan and request to be a consulting party with this project.

Our main concerns at the Delaware Nation on these types of projects are as follows:

1. Keeping a 50-100 ft (at least) area of protection around known sites.
2. Maintaining the buffer area and not allowing heavy equipment to impact these areas. Compression is an issue of concern for us. Be mindful of material staging/storage areas.
3. Protection of indigenous plants and/or re-introduction of the indigenous plants to the area is important to the Delaware Nation. Many of these are considered Traditional Cultural Properties for our people.
4. And if something is found, halting all work, contacting us within 48 hours and when work resumes discussion of a monitor if needed.

As with any new project, we never know what may come to light until work begins. The Delaware Nation asks that you keep us up to date on the progress of this project and if any discoveries arise please contact us immediately.

Our department is trying to go as paper free as possible. If it is at all feasible for your office to send email correspondence we would greatly appreciate.

If you need anything additional from me please do not hesitate to contact me.
