On October 13, 2017, the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission issued to Mountain Valley Pipeline, LLC a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing the construction and operation of the Mountain Valley Pipeline Project (“MVP Project”).

In accordance with Section 2.55(a)(2)(ii) of the Commission’s regulations, Mountain Valley is providing this 30-day advance notification of the construction of certain auxiliary facilities. Specifically, Mountain Valley will install two additional taps and related facilities during construction of the MVP Project:


- The first tap will be located at approximate milepost 84.50 of the MVP Project in Nicholas County, West Virginia. Mountain Valley is installing the tap for a potential future delivery point. Mountain Valley will design and install the pipeline tap, tap valve, and appurtenant piping within the MVP Project’s permanent right-of-way.
- The second tap will be located at approximate milepost 303.27 of the MVP Project in Pittsylvania County, Virginia. Mountain Valley is installing the tap to supply gas to the MVP Southgate Project, which is currently in the pre-filing stage. Mountain Valley will design and install the pipeline tap, tap valve, and appurtenant piping within the MVP Project’s permanent right-of-way.
