We have received documentation intended to fulfill stipulations outlined in *Mountain Valley Pipeline Project, Volume IV Addendum – REVISED*, dated May 2018 and prepared for the aforementioned project. As required by Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966, as amended, its implementing regulations, 36 CFR 800: "Protection of Historic Properties," and the Programmatic Agreement (PA) prepared for the undertaking, we submit our comments.

We have reviewed the submission and acknowledge that MVP has installed jersey barriers on the Huffman Farmstead (ME-0389) near the contributing barn structure on that property. This fulfills stipulations of project avoidance and minimization as addressed in consultation between our office and Tetra Tech, consultants operating on behalf of MVP. We will provide additional comments as more project information is made available.
