On October 23, 2015, Mountain Valley Pipeline, LLC (“Mountain Valley” or “MVP”) filed a certificate application with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (“Commission” or “FERC”) for the Mountain Valley Pipeline Project (“Project”) in the above-identified docket. On June 23, 2017, the Commission issued the Final Environmental Impact Statement (“FEIS”) for the Project.

In this filing, Mountain Valley submits the following supplemental materials:

- Upland Forest Impact Assessment and Voluntary Mitigation Plan, which is an updated version of the Habitat Mitigation Plan that was filed on May 11, 2017, based on continuing consultation with relevant agencies.
- Analysis of Comments by Virginia Department of Conservation and Recreation on MVP’s Forest Impact Analysis, which is a response to the letter filed by the Virginia Department of Conservation and Recreation (VDCR) that was filed on July 21, 2017. This document includes two appendices. Due to its size, Appendix B (which consists of maps) is attached separately. MVP met with staff from VDCR to discuss the comments and MVP’s response on July 13, 2017; August 23, 2017; and August 31, 2017.
